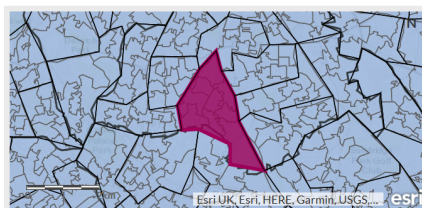


Bellingham

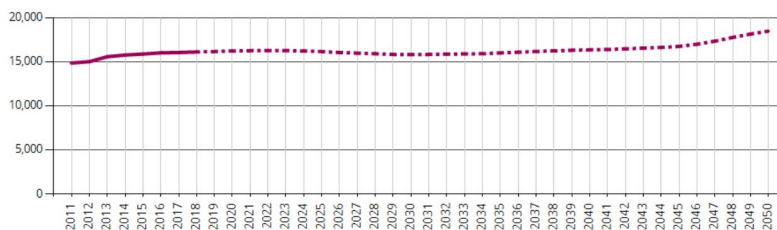

Bellingham, Population projection

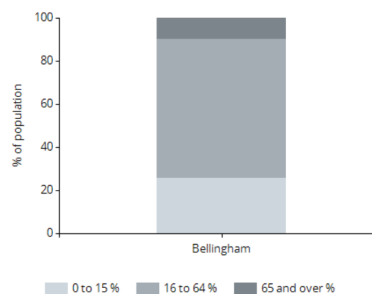


Age group breakdown projections for Bellingham (2018)

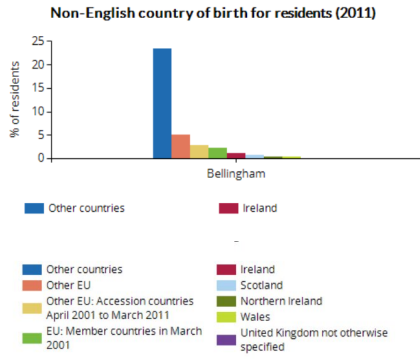

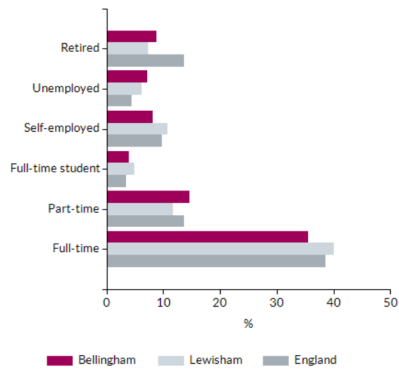

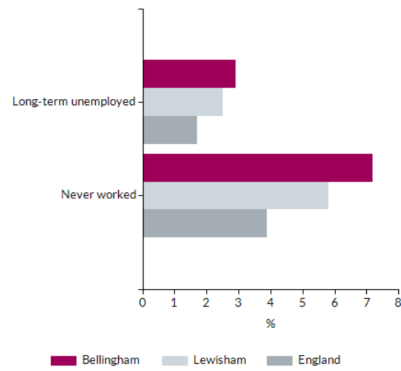

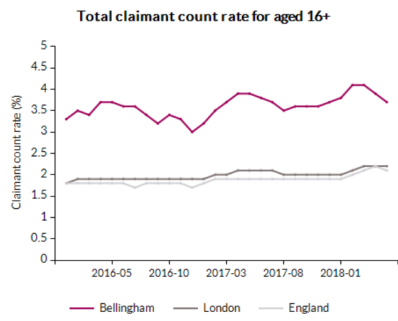

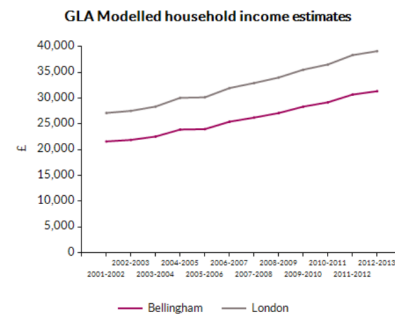

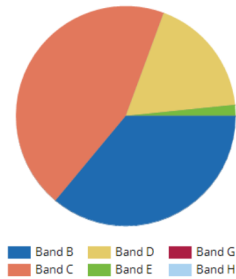

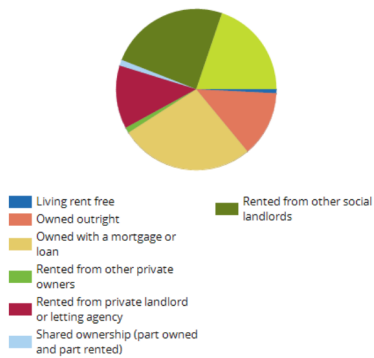

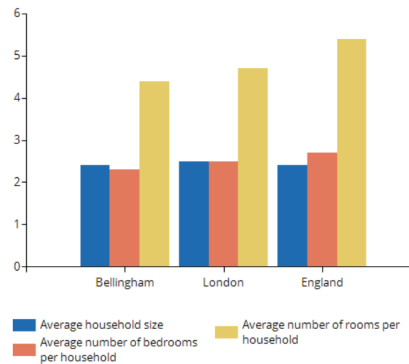


Property ownership in Bellingham, 2011

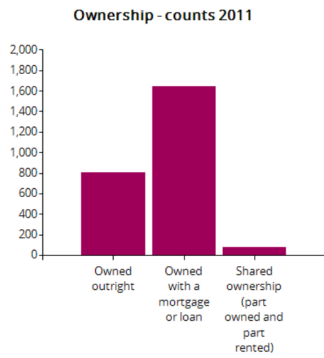

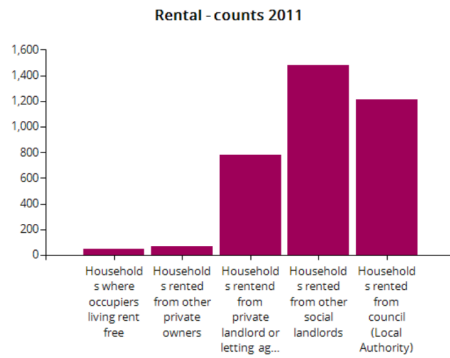
Household size and rooms in Bellingham, 2011

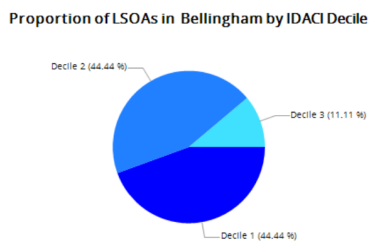

Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index (IDACI) Decile:

The Indices of Deprivation 2015 provide a set of relative measures of deprivation for small areas (Lower-layer Super Output Areas) across England.

The IADCI is a subset of the Income Deprivation Domain, with the Index showing the proportion of children aged 0 - 15 in each Lower-layer Super Output Area that live in families that are income deprived (those that are in receipt of Income Support, income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, Pension Credit Guarantee or Child Tax Credit below a given threshold).

The pie chart shows the proportion of Isoa's in Bellingham in each decile with decile 1 being the most deprived 10% of areas in England.

Community Safety

This overview section looks at the overall crime figures of the local area as well as the crime rates split by types.

data.police.uk * = single crime case data have been aggregated to Ward level. Rates are calculated per 1000 population. 12 month rolling figures use an average of the population monthly figures over the same period. Where the dates for the crime data exceed the latest available date for population estimates, the latest population figure was used for any crime rates after that date (no extrapolating).

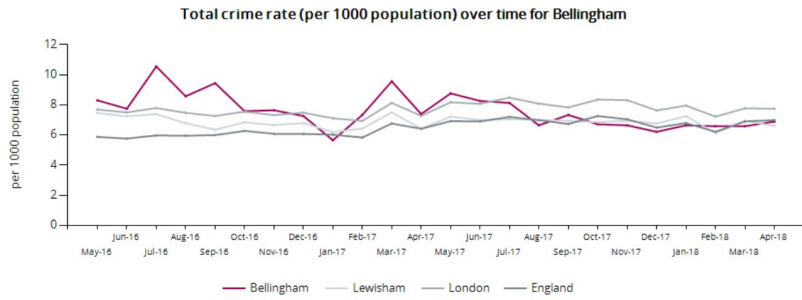

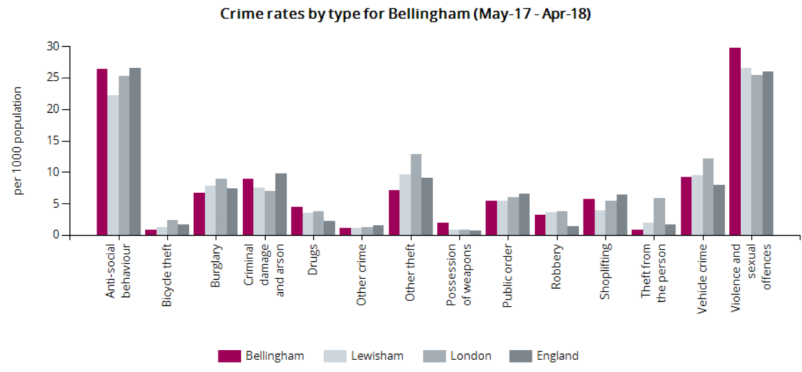

Deprivation

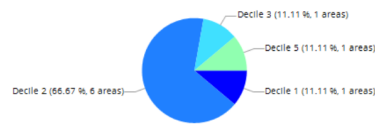
The Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) 2015 is the official measure of relative deprivation for small areas (or neighbourhoods) in England. The Index of Multiple Deprivation ranks every small area (Lsoa) in England from 1 (most deprived area) to 32,844 (least deprived area).

For larger areas like Wards we can look at the proportion of LSOAs within the ward that lie within each decile. Decile 1 represents the most deprived 10% of LSOAs in England while decile 10 shows the least deprived 10% of areas.

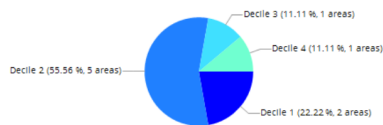

Proportion of LSOAs in Bellingham by Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) Decile

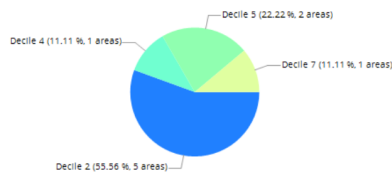


Proportion of LSOAs in Bellingham by Income Decile



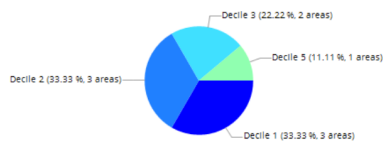

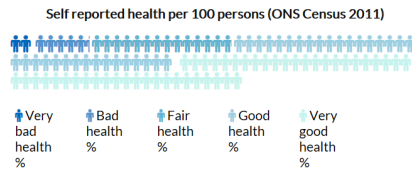

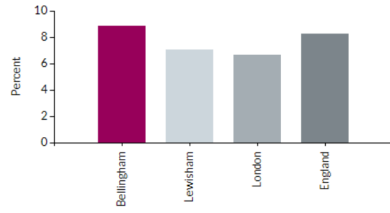

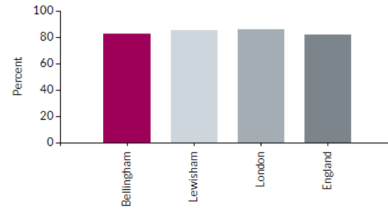

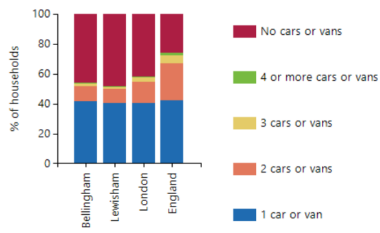

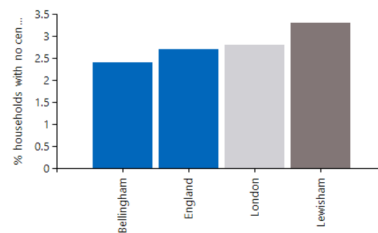
